

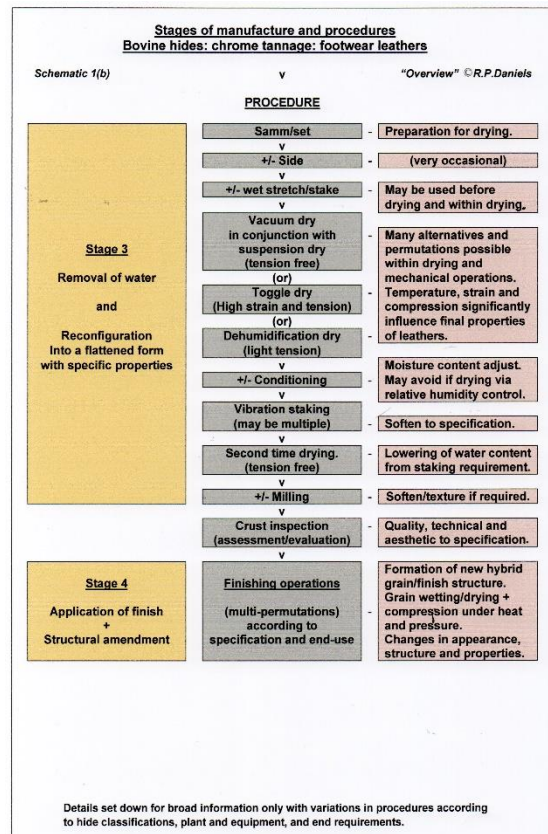
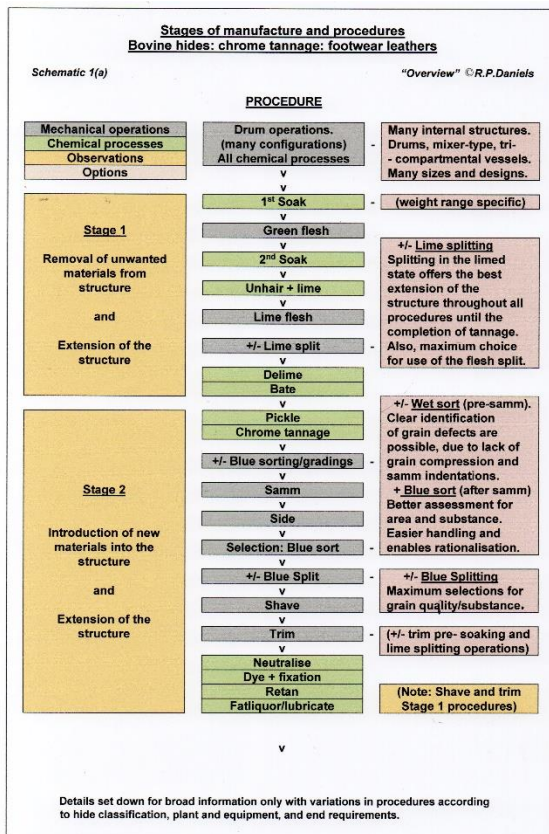
Making Leather: AN OVERVIEW OF MANUFACTURE
